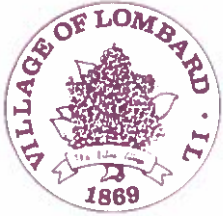

Subject: FY14 New Vehicle Purchase

At the FY14 vehicle review meeting we decided to retain car #CE204 for one more year because the maintenance costs and mileage on the vehicle were low. Since then this vehicle (a 2004 Ford Freestar van) has developed a transmission problem that would require the transmission to be completely rebuilt. This repair would come close to the value of the car so staff would like to replace it at this time.

Staff would like to replace this vehicle with a more fuel efficient Ford Transit Connect. This would suit the Code Enforcement Division's needs and also lower operating costs. The budgeted amount we have in reserve for this purchase is \$18,588 and we will see additional proceeds from the sale of unit #CE204 at auction. This vehicle is available for joint purchase through the SPC. The current SPC contract winner for this type of vehicle is Currie Motors of Frankfort (IL). The price of the vehicle with options is \$22,324. Any shortfall will be made up by savings from other FY14 vehicle purchases.

I recommend the B.O.T. waive bid and award a contract to Currie Motors of Frankfort (IL) in the amount of \$22,324 for one new Ford Transit Connect as optioned. I also recommend declaring Village unit #CE204 as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing its sale at public auction. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the February 20, 2014 meeting.

ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE BY PUBLIC AUCTION OF PERSONAL
PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD**

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard, it is no longer necessary or useful to or in the best interest for the Village of Lombard to retain ownership of the personal property hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard to sell said personal property at public auction to be held Obenauf Auction Service. Vehicles valued less than the cost of auction fees and would not result in a net profit for the Village shall be sold directly to a salvage yard.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF
TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:**

Section 1: Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the President and Board of Trustees find the following described property:

now owned by the Village of Lombard is no longer necessary or useful to the Village of Lombard and the best interests of the Village of Lombard will be served by its sale.

Section 2: Pursuant to said 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village President and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sell the aforementioned personal property now owned by the Village of Lombard, at public auction, by Obenauf Auction Service to the highest bidder on said property. Vehicles valued less than the cost of auction fees and would not result in a net profit for the Village shall be sold directly to a salvage yard.

Section 3: The Village Manager is hereby authorized and may direct Obenauf Auction Service to advertise the sale of the aforementioned personal property in a newspaper published within the community before the date of said public auction.

Section 4: No bid which is less than the minimum price set forth in the list of property to be sold shall be accepted.

Section 5: The Village Manager or his designee shall cause to be transferred any titles or other legal documents pursuant to the sale.

Section 6: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval as provided by law.
