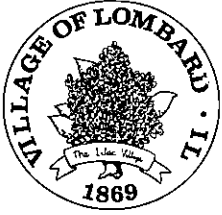

Attached please find a contract and resolution pertaining to the resident engineering services for Special Assessment 219 (School Street and Morris Avenue). This project also includes Ahrens and Morris Avenues. Morris (Fairfield Avenue to Ahrens Avenue) and Ahrens Avenue are not part of Special Assessment 219 but are included under the same construction contract.

This selection was made from the Resident Engineering Short List. The short list is comprised of six firms. All six firms responded. Upon review, the Engineering Division determined that Burns & McDonnell of Downers Grove is the most qualified firm to serve as resident engineer.

Burns & McDonnell's most recent resident engineering projects for the Village include North Broadway Improvements, Special Assessment 213B, Main Street Streetscape and North Avenue Utility Improvements.

The scope and fee were negotiated with Burns & McDonnell and agreed to by both parties. The not-to-exceed fee for resident engineering services is \$181,706.78.

Please present this agreement and resolution to the President and Board of Trustees for their review at their regular meeting of April 20, 2006. If approved, please return one original signed copy returned to Public Works-Engineering for further processing.
