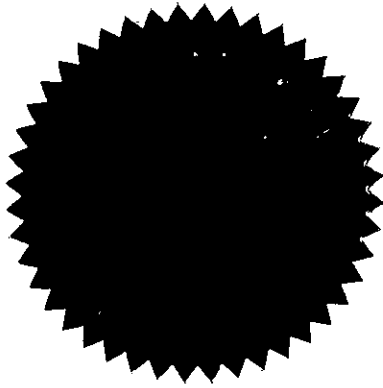

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF
MUNICIPAL OWNED PROPERTY

ORDINANCE NO. _____ 5014

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard, it is no longer necessary or useful to or in the best interest for the Village of Lombard to retain the following described personal medical property:

- (2) Lifestat 100 blood pressure monitors
- (2) CRC. Stand alone pacemakers
- (5) Panasonic bag phones
- (2) Miscellaneous battery chargers
- (1) Motorola medical radio-donated to department for possible public education use

WHEREAS, the Village routinely declares such type of surplus and the best interest of the Village of Lombard will be served by its donation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:
