**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING PUBLIC SIDEWALK, SANITARY SEWER,
STORM SEWER, WATER MAIN AND FIRE HYDRANTS AT ST. THOMAS
MARTHOMA CHURCH, 710 N. MAIN STREET, IN LOMBARD, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the Private Engineering Services Division of the Village of Lombard has certified the completion of the public sidewalk, storm sewer, sanitary sewer, water main and fire hydrant and on-site 8-inch water main and fire hydrant at 710 N. Main Street, and has recommended that said improvements be accepted; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities concur with said recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the public improvements, as certified by the Private Engineering Services Division and as set forth on the approved engineering plans for the public sidewalk, storm sewer, sanitary sewer, water main and fire hydrant and on-site 8-inch water main and fire hydrant at 710 N. Main Street, be and hereby are accepted for ownership by the Village of Lombard.

SECTION 2: That the on-site sanitary sewer, two-inch and six-inch water main and all on-site storm sewer are to remain the responsibility of the property owner.

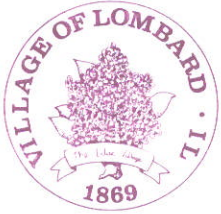




