Number of Authorized Liquor Licenses

Trademark Tavern LLC d/b/a Trademark Tavern & Tap located at 777 E. Butterfield Road currently holds an A/B-II liquor license which is effective through November 30, 2013. On Monday, October 7, 2013 this business establishment ceased operations. Staff advised the owner of Trademark Tavern & Tap that the Village Board would be voting on decreasing the number of liquor licenses in the A/B –II category by one, prior to the license expiring, to reflect the closing of their business (see attached). As staff has not heard any objection from the owner of Trademark Tavern & Tap, attached is an ordinance decreasing the Class A/B-II liquor license category by one as required by Village Code.

Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading in order to bring the number of licenses available in the A/B-II classification current to reflect this change.

ORDINANCE	

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.13 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended BY REVISING THE ENTRY RELATIVE TO THE Class A/B-II liquor licenses contained therein, to read as follows:

"Class A/B-II – 9"

Section 2: That the change in the number of Class A/B-II liquor licenses set forth in Section 1 above, is a result of Trademark Tavern LLC d/b/a Trademark Tavern & Tap no longer conducting business at 777 E. Butterfield Road.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its
