During afternoon pick-up, parents have been stopping on both sides of Lincoln to wait for their children. This situation impedes the flow of traffic on Lincoln in an already congested area. All parties agreed that on the west side of Lincoln between Wilson and Graham the "No Parking, School Days" should be changed to "No Parking, Standing, Stopping, School Days, 9AM-3PM".

Signs were installed under the Authorization for Temporary or Emergency Placement of Traffic Control Regulation or Device.
