The purpose of this memo is to provide an update on the status of my review and appointment recommendations for the Lombard Plan Commission. First and foremost, thank you for your efforts in communicating the current vacancies and calling for new applicants from across the community. It is my understanding that since July 1, the Village has received over 50 applications for our 12 vacant positions spread out amongst six (6) statutory commissions and localized committees. I am confident that the applications submitted will provide us with highly qualified and involved volunteers to help provide guidance to the Village Board on key policy and development issues. In addition, for those not selected, I know that we will have a deep bench to go to when future vacancies arise.

With regards to the Plan Commission, there are presently two (2) vacancies for which a total of seven (7) applications were received. Given the number of applications submitted, I requested that a senior member of our Plan Commission, Ruth Sweetser, be included in a preliminary interview process of the applicants. With the assistance of staff, Ruth met with interested parties in early September. Following that time, a short list of three (3) finalists were submitted to me. I conducted personal interviews with each of the finalists during the week of September 27. I can inform you that while I did not know any of the finalists before this week, all of them are qualified individuals who are seeking to serve the community. That being said, upon consideration of the candidates, I am recommending the appointment of the following residents to fill the two (2) vacant positions on the Plan Commission:

Alissa Verson — Alissa is a lifelong resident of Lombard who attended grade school and high school in town. After graduating college, she and her family made the decision to move to Lombard. She is interested in serving as a volunteer in the community where she has chosen to live. Professionally, she works as an attorney. She has excellent listening skills, writing skills and has an eye for detail. These are attributes that will serve the Plan Commission well. In addition, due to her training and experience as an attorney, she has the ability to interpret rules, codes and regulations which is a necessary requirement for Plan Commission Members.

Robert Spreenburg – Robert is a newer resident to Lombard having moved to town in 2017. He also is interested in serving as a volunteer because he wants to give back to the community where he lives and help make it a better place to raise a family. Professionally, he works as an engineer which has benefits in terms of reviewing building plans and items related to storm water, flooding and construction. Robert is an intelligent person who believes it is important to be rational and reasonable when looking at issues and projects that may be emotional at times. These skills will benefit the Plan Commission as he applies them to his review and comment on proposed plans being considered.

A copy of the applications submitted for the above recommended candidates are attached to this memo. Please note that personal information including phone number, email and address have been redacted due to privacy concerns as this document will be included on a posted agenda.

Again, thank you for your efforts in communicating the vacant positions and assisting with the process. I would kindly ask that you distribute this memorandum to the Village Board for their information and take the necessary steps to have the appointments placed on the regularly scheduled Village Board meeting of October 21, 2021 for formal vote by the Village Board.
