As part of the FY 2010 plan to reduce the fleet and costs we are replacing truck FR85 (a 2003 Ford F550 utility truck) used by the Fire Department with a 12 foot enclosed trailer. The Fire Department has a 8 foot enclosed trailer (unit # FR916) that they no longer use and would like to trade it in on the purchase of the new 12 foot trailer. Fleet Services has gathered three written quotes and Advantage Trailer of Carol Stream (IL) was the lowest. The trailer cost \$6,438 minus a trade-in value of \$1,744 equals a net cost of \$4,694.

I recommend declaring Village unit # FR916 as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing its trade-in to Advantage Trailer of Carol Stream (IL) for \$1,744. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the April 1, 2010 meeting.
