

MINUTES of a regular public meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, held in the Village Hall Board Room, 255 East Wilson Avenue, Lombard, Illinois, in said Village, at 7:00 o'clock P.M., on the 18th day of January, 2024.

Upon the roll being called, Keith T. Giagnorio, the President, and the following Trustees were physically present at said location: Trustee LaVaque, Dudek, Puccio, Honig, and Militello.

The following Trustees were allowed by a majority of the President and Board of Trustees in accordance with and to the extent allowed by rules adopted by the President and Board of Trustees to attend the meeting by video or audio conference: None.

No Trustee was not permitted to attend the meeting by video or audio conference.

The following Trustees were absent and did not participate in the meeting in any manner or to any extent whatsoever: Trustee Bachner.

The President announced that the next item of business before the President and Board of Trustees was the consideration of an ordinance terminating the Direction Regarding Direct Deposit of Certain Sales Tax Revenues with Amalgamated Bank of Chicago, as Escrow Agent, executed by the Village in connection with the issuance of the Village's Obligation Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source), Series 2018.

Whereupon President Giagnorio presented and the Village Clerk read by title an ordinance as follows, a copy of which was provided to each Trustee prior to said meeting and to everyone in attendance at said meeting who requested a copy:

ORDINANCE NO. 8234

AN ORDINANCE terminating the direction of certain sales tax revenues of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, to an escrow agent in connection with the Village's General Obligation Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source), Series 2018.

WHEREAS, the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois (the "*Village*"), is a duly organized and existing municipality incorporated and existing under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended (the "*Municipal Code*"); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees (the "*Board*") of the Village, by an ordinance adopted on the 20th day of September, 2018 (the "*Bond Ordinance*"), did provide for the issue of \$3,900,000 General Obligation Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source), Series 2018, dated October 11, 2018 (the "*Bonds*"); and

WHEREAS, in connection with the issuance of the Bonds and for the purpose of enhancing the marketability of the Bonds, the Village entered into the Pledged Moneys Escrow Agreement between the Village and Amalgamated Bank of Chicago, Chicago, Illinois, as escrow agent (the "*Escrow Agent*"), dated as of October 11, 2018 (the "*Escrow Agreement*"), which provided for the deposit of the Pledged Revenues (as defined in the Bond Ordinance) into an account held by the Escrow Agent under the Escrow Agreement (the "*Escrow Account*") for the purpose of further securing the repayment of the Bonds; and

WHEREAS, on the 20th day of September, 2018, the Village executed that certain Direction Regarding the Direct Deposit of Certain Sales Tax Revenues with Amalgamated Bank of Chicago, as Escrow Agent (the "*Direction*"), to the Department of Revenue of the State of Illinois (the "*Department*"), pursuant to which the Village directed the Department to segregate and deposit directly with the Escrow Agent for deposit into the Escrow Account all of the

Village's Sales Tax Revenues (as defined in the Direction) until the Bonds are no longer outstanding; and

WHEREAS, the Direction was filed with the Department on the 3rd day of October, 2018, and is now in full force and effect; and

WHEREAS, the final payment of principal of and interest on the Bonds was paid on January 1, 2024, and, as such, the Bonds are no longer outstanding; and

WHEREAS, the Escrow Agreement, by its terms, terminates upon the payment in full of the Bonds and the transfer of any balance held in the Escrow Agreement to the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined and does hereby determine that all of the requirements for the termination of the Escrow Agreement and the Direction have been met; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the Village that the Direction be terminated and Sales Tax Revenues due to the Village in the future be paid directly to the Village treasury:

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It and It Is Hereby Ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:


Section 1. Incorporation of Preambles. The Board hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

Section 2. Authorization to Terminate Direction. The Board hereby determines that the Direction shall be terminated. The Village Manager and the Finance Director of the Village are each authorized to take any additional actions, including execution of any necessary documents, which may be necessary to terminate the Direction.

Section 3. Filing of Ordinance. Forthwith upon the adoption of this Ordinance, a certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the Department for the purpose of demonstrating the action taken by the Board to authorize the termination of the Direction.


Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption.
