BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS: Attached for your consideration is an ordinance amending Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A), amending Class "EE" liquor classification to add "kitchens shall be allowed; further, food may be provided to the patrons, from restaurants that have entered into an agreement with the liquor licensee to deliver carry-out food to the licensed premises. However, licensees shall be required to provide or sell, at a minimum, pre-packaged snacks, such as pretzels and potato chips in the manufacturer's original packaging, to patrons of the licensed premises."					
Currently, there is one establishment that holds the Class "EE" liquor license and one prospective licensee, GSBR CHI-Town LLC d/b/a Game Show Battle Rooms, an indoor amusement establishment, that the Board of Trustees recently approved a Conditional Use Permit for 2820 S. SUBJECT: Class "EE" Liquor License Category

Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A) of the Village Code currently defines the Class "EE" liquor license category as:

Class "EE"—Beer and wine only served as an adjunct to a place of amusement not covered by a Class "E", Class "M" or Class "R" liquor license, for consumption on the premises only and only by paying patrons of the place of amusement (those individuals who have paid for access to the amusements on the licensed premises). No kitchen shall be allowed; however, food may be provided to the patrons, from restaurants that have entered into an agreement with the liquor licensee to deliver carry-out food to the licensed premises. No package sales shall be allowed. Video gaming, as provided for under the Illinois Video Gaming Act, shall not be allowed on the licensed premises.

Village staff is requesting to amend this code to include "kitchens shall be allowed; further, food may be provided to the patrons, from restaurants that have entered into an agreement with the liquor licensee to deliver carry-out food to the licensed premises. However, licensees shall be required to provide or sell, at a minimum, pre-packaged snacks, such as pretzels and potato chips in the manufacturer's original packaging, to patrons of the licensed premises" within the description of the current Class "EE" liquor license category.

Attached is an ordinance amending Village Code Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A), Class "EE" liquor license category, adding the requested amended language.

Currently there is one establishment that holds a Class "EE". A prospective licensee, GSBR CHI-Town LLC d/b/a Game Show Battle Rooms, was recently approved for a Conditional Use Permit for 2820 S. Highland Avenue, Unit A, at the August 17, 2023, Board of Trustees Meeting and is requesting the Class "EE" liquor license.

Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.12(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO CLASS "EE" LIQUOR LICENSES

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title XI, Chapter 112, Article II, Section 112.12(A) of the Lombard Village Code, is hereby amended by revising the description of a Class "EE" liquor license to read in its entirety as follows:

"(d) Class "EE" – Beer and wine only served as an adjunct to a place of amusement not covered by a Class "E", Class "M" or Class "R" liquor license, for consumption on the premises only and only by paying patrons of the place of amusement (those individuals who have paid for access to the amusements on the licensed premises). Kitchens shall be allowed; further, food may be provided to the patrons, from restaurants that have entered into an agreement with the liquor licensee to deliver carry-out food to the licensed premises. However, licensees shall be required to provide or sell, at a minimum, prepackaged snacks, such as pretzels and potato chips in the manufacturer's original packaging, to patrons of the licensed premises. No package sales shall be allowed. Video gaming, as provided for under the Illinois Video Gaming Act, shall not be allowed on the licensed premises."

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
