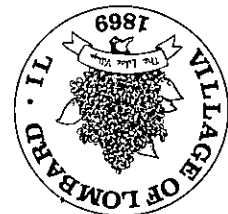

SUBJECT: DUPAGE COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

Background:

DuPage County is in the process of preparing a natural hazards mitigation plan for the County and all interested municipalities. The purpose of the plan is to identify activities that can be undertaken at all levels of government and by the private sector that can reduce safety and health hazards and property damage caused by natural hazards.

In order for the Village of Lombard to be eligible for disaster mitigation funds from FEMA, we must participate in the planning process of developing and adopting multi-jurisdictional or countywide plans. As such, DuPage County has extended an invitation to the Village of Lombard to participate in these activities. The County has requested that the Village adopt the attached resolution as well as identify a staff liaison. Planning sessions began on May 23, 2006 and will tentatively meet the fourth Tuesday of every month.

Recommendation:

That the Village Board of Trustees approve the attached resolution authorizing the Village's participation in this planning process as well as appointing David Huliseberg and David Gorman as staff liaisons.

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Whereas the ~~City~~ Village of Lombard is subject to natural hazards, such as, floods, earthquakes, tornadoes, severe winter and summer storms that can damage property, close businesses, disrupt traffic, and present a public health and safety hazard; and

Whereas DuPage County is undertaking a natural hazards mitigation plan for the County; and  
Whereas the County has invited the ~~City~~ Village of Lombard to participate in and benefit from this planning effort; and

Whereas several Federal programs require that the ~~City~~ Village of Lombard have an adopted hazard mitigation plan to qualify for their benefits;

Now, therefore, be it resolved that:

1. The ~~City~~ Village of Lombard hereby states its interest in participating in the County's mitigation planning process.
2. David Gorman and David Hulseberg is hereby appointed as our representative on the County's Mitigation Workgroup. ~~He/she~~ is charged with: They are

- a. Attending the regular meetings of the County's Mitigation Workgroup;
- b. Keeping ~~City~~ Village staff and this ~~County~~ Board of Trustees informed of the Workgroup's activities and recommendations;
- c. Assisting the County's efforts to collect information about the hazards facing the ~~City~~ Village of Lombard and our current policies and programs that can mitigate the impacts of those hazards; and
- d. Obtaining input from ~~City~~ Village staff on mitigation issues relevant to their work.

3. When the County's Mitigation Workgroup has completed its work and presents its recommended plan, this ~~County~~ Board of Trustees will review it with the intention of adopting all or parts of it. It is understood that this resolution of commitment to participate in the planning process does not constitute a commitment to enact the recommended plan.
