Contract Extension

The Catch Basin Cleaning Project is designed to supplement the annual catch basin cleaning program performed by Village crews. The Village has a goal of cleaning one-third of the Village-owned catch basins each year. This program is one component of the Combined Sewer Overflow Operations & Maintenance Plan required by the IEPA Permit for the Lombard Combined Sewerage Treatment Plant to reduce sediment entering the treatment plant during rain storms.

The Catch Basin Cleaning Project is budgeted in the Water & Sewer Capital Reserve Fund at a cost of \$50,000 for FY 09/10. On June 5, 2008, the Village Board awarded a contract to Midwest Trenchless Technologies of Belle Plaine, MN for Catch Basin Cleaning for FY 08/09. The bid contained an option for a one year contract renewal. Attached is a letter from Midwest Trenchless Technologies, Inc. indicating their willingness to provide the same services under the same terms, conditions and unit prices for an additional year.

To exercise the renewal option, the Village Attorney has stated that the Village Board must approve acceptance of the renewal. There is no need to sign a new contract. If approved by the Village Board, staff would send a confirming letter with signature space for Midwest Trenchless Technologies, Inc. to accept the extension of the contract. Midwest Trenchless Technologies, Inc. performed satisfactorily in the past.

Therefore, I am requesting the Board of Trustees waive bids and renew the contract with Midwest Trenchless Technologies, Inc. of Belle Plaine, MN, for Catch Basin Cleaning for one year under the same terms, conditions and unit prices in an amount equal to the total budgeted amount of \$50,000 for FY 09/10 at their June 18, 2009 meeting.
