Subject: Award Bid #FS0908, Two Tandem Axle Dump Trucks

The FY 2009 budget includes replacement of Village unit # ST340 and # WT436, two tandem axle dump trucks. The bid results for the two new trucks are as follows:

Vendor	Bid Price	Less Trade-In	Net Total Bid
Freeway Ford Lyons (IL)	318,663	47,332	271,331
Truck City Gary (IN)	330,947	50,000	280,947
Northwest Ford Franklin Park (IL)	332,961	40,000	292,961

Public Works received three sealed bids. Freeway Ford was the lowest bid but did not meet our specifications. Freeway substituted a salt spreader made out of 201 stainless steel instead of 304 stainless as specified. 201 stainless is \$4,000 to \$5,000 cheaper than 304. This type of stainless is new to this application and its longevity is un-proven. Additionally Freeway substituted different hydraulic controls and a smaller display screen which operators use during salting operations. It is our goal to keep these controls as uniform as possible from truck to truck.

Truck City of Gary was the lowest bid meeting our specifications. The bid price for the two new tandem axle dump trucks is \$330,947 less a trade-in allowance of \$50,000 equals a net total bid of \$280,947. The budgeted amount for these vehicles is \$300,000.

I recommend the award of a contract to Truck City of Gary (IN) in the amount of \$280,947 for two new tandem axle dump trucks. I also recommend declaring Village unit # ST340 and # WT436, two tandem axle dump trucks, as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing their trade-in. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the February 7, 2008 meeting.
