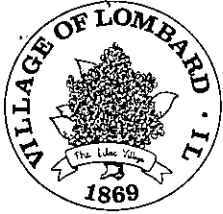

Delete: Schedule XX (d) – No Stopping, Standing or Parking

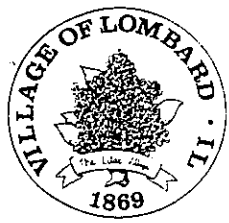
- Berkshire, south side, from Kramer to a point 185 east.

Add: Schedule VI – Section 10-9-6 - One-Way Streets

- Clarendon, northbound, between Berkshire and Sunset on school days between 7:30 AM – 8:30 AM and 2 PM – 3 PM.

Subject: Schafer School Signage Changes

Officer Joe Wagner, of the Lombard Police Department, observed some traffic problems on Berkshire between Vista and Westwood. Vehicles were double parking and making it difficult for through traffic to flow. In one particular instance, southbound traffic on Clarendon was trying to merge with eastbound traffic on Berkshire. To correct this situation, a temporary "One Way" with a supplementary sign that reads "School Days, 7:30 AM - 8:30 AM, 2 PM - 3 PM" was installed for northbound Clarendon. Signs were also installed on Clarendon and Sunset to advise drivers of the "One Way" signage.

The second problem was the somewhat confusing signage on the south side of Berkshire. The signage that pertained to "No Parking" was removed. Then 3 types of signs were installed in the drop off zone that read, "Student Drop Off and Pickup", "Pull Forward" and "Do Not Leave Your Vehicle".

Use of the "Bus Zone" for pickup and drop off was the third problem. A "Bus Zone When Flashing" sign was mounted to an A-frame sign stand with a yellow flasher. This will be put out in the street at the appropriate bus pickup and drop off times. At other times, parents will be able to use this zone, which will improve the drop off and pickup of children.

A fourth problem was the mid-block crosswalk. Although the crossing is safe, a portable stop sign was mounted to a plastic "A" frame sign stand with a red flashing light and placed in the middle of the street near the crosswalk. This will improve the wellbeing of the children that are crossing.

I would recommend accepting the above improvements in order to increase the safety of the children and create a more orderly movement of traffic.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule XX (d) of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled NO STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING be amended to delete the following therefrom:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>
Berkshire Avenue South side	Kramer	a point 185 feet east

Section 2: That Schedule VI of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled ONE-WAY STREETS be amended to add the following thereto:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Direction of Traffic Movement</u>
Clarendon Avenue from Berkshire Ave. to Sunset Street on school days between 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 am. and 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.	North

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
