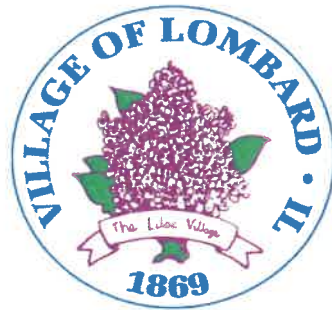

**ORDINANCE NO. 8201**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 112,  
SECTION 112.12(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE  
IN REGARD TO CLASS "EE" LIQUOR LICENSES**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That Title XI, Chapter 112, Article II, Section 112.12(A) of the Lombard Village Code, is hereby amended by revising the description of a Class "EE" liquor license to read in its entirety as follows:

"(d) Class "EE" – Beer and wine only served as an adjunct to a place of amusement not covered by a Class "E", Class "M" or Class "R" liquor license, for consumption on the premises only and only by paying patrons of the place of amusement (those individuals who have paid for access to the amusements on the licensed premises). Kitchens shall be allowed; further, food may be provided to the patrons, from restaurants that have entered into an agreement with the liquor licensee to deliver carry-out food to the licensed premises. However, licensees shall be required to provide or sell, at a minimum, pre-packaged snacks, such as pretzels and potato chips in the manufacturer's original packaging, to patrons of the licensed premises. No package sales shall be allowed. Video gaming, as provided for under the Illinois Video Gaming Act, shall not be allowed on the licensed premises."

**SECTION 2:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
