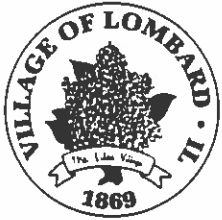

The below squad car was driven through high water during the recent flood causing catastrophic engine failure. This vehicle (unit # PP731) was scheduled to be replaced this year and the replacement vehicle is already on order. The cost to repair this vehicle would exceed the value of the car and therefore I would recommend selling the car as is. PW would like to try a new online auction company that some other communities in the area have used and are happy with. The Village may be able to get a little more in return using this method. The company is called Obenauf Auction Service (www.obenaufauctions.com).

I recommend the Board of Trustees declare the below vehicle as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorize its sale through Obenauf Auction Service. ORDINANCE _____

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE BY PUBLIC AUCTION OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard, it is no longer necessary or useful to or in the best interest for the Village of Lombard to retain ownership of the personal property hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard to sell said personal property at public auction to be held Obenauf Auction Service. Vehicles valued less than the cost of auction fees and would not result in a net profit for the Village shall be sold directly to a salvage yard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the President and Board of Trustees find the following described property:

Section 2: Pursuant to said 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village President and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sell the aforementioned personal property now owned by the Village of Lombard, at public auction, by Obenauf Auction Service to the highest bidder on said property. Vehicles valued less than the cost of auction fees and would not result in a net profit for the Village shall be sold directly to a salvage yard.

Section 3: The Village Manager is hereby authorized and may direct Obenauf Auction Service to advertise the sale of the aforementioned personal property in a newspaper published within the community before the date of said public auction.

Section 4: No bid which is less than the minimum price set forth in the list of property to be sold shall be accepted.

Section 5: The Village Manager or his designee shall cause to be transferred any titles or other legal documents pursuant to the sale.

Section 6: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval as provided by law.
