Subject: FY12 Vehicle Joint Purchase

Included in the FY12 budget is the replacement of two Police Department vehicles, unit number PP727 (2007 Dodge Charger) and PP789 (2008 Ford Expedition). These vehicles will be replaced by a Ford Police Interceptor sedan (car body style) and utility (SUV body style) respectively. Both these vehicles are available for purchase through the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative (SPC). The current contract winner for the SPC is Currie Motors of Frankfort (IL). The cost of the sedan is \$23,885 and the utility is \$25,815 or \$49,700 for both vehicles. The budgeted amount for these vehicles is \$49,000 which makes this purchase \$700 over budget. This shortfall will be made up by savings from other FY12 vehicle purchases.

I recommend the B.O.T. waive bid and award a contract to Currie Motors of Frankfort (IL) in the amount of \$49,700 for one new Ford Police Interceptor sedan and one new Interceptor utility. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the December 15, 2011 meeting.
