## ORDINANCE AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.13 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "A/B III" liquor license, contained therein, to read as follows, effective December, 2005:

Class "A/B III" - 10

This increase in Class "A/B III" liquor licenses reflects the issuance of a Class "A/B III" liquor license to Claim Jumper Restaurants, LLC located at 92 Yorktown Center who will be operating the business commonly known as Claim Jumper Restaurant.
