FY12 State Bid Vehicle Purchase

Included in the FY 2012 budget is the replacement for a Public Works Street Department tandem axle dump truck with plow and salt spreader (unit # ST329). State bid for this type of vehicle has been awarded to Prairie International Trucks (contract # 4015050) of Springfield (IL). The cost of the truck is \$153,395. Prairie International has offered an \$11,000 trade-in allowance for our old truck; this makes the total amount needed for this purchase \$142,395. The budgeted amount for this purchase is \$147,000.

I recommend the B.O.T. waive bid and award a contract to Prairie International of Springfield (IL) in the amount of \$142,395 for one new tandem axle dump truck with plow and salt spreader. I also recommend declaring Village unit # ST329 as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing its trade-in. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance.
