**SUBJECT**: An Ordinance Establishing Registration and Registration Fees in Relation to

Video Gaming Terminals

Attached please find a copy of *An Ordinance Amending Title 11, Chapter 110 of the Lombard Village Code of in Regard to the Registration of Video Gaming Terminals and a Registration Fee in Relation Thereto.* In the event that the current ban on video gaming is rescinded, the Village of Lombard would need to amend Title 11, Chapter 110 of the Lombard Village Code to provide for the local registration of video gaming terminals and the establishment of an annual registration fee.

Pursuant to the proposed Ordinance, any licensed establishment seeking to have video gaming terminals would be required to annually complete a registration application through the Village and pay an annual registration fee of \$25.00 per gaming terminal. The Illinois Video Gaming Act limits the registration fee a non-home rule municipality may assess for a gaming terminal to a maximum of \$25.00 per gaming terminal.
