BACKGROUND

Sacred Heart will be hosting its annual Germanfest carnival which will take place from July 17 through July 20, 2008. The church is requesting to be allowed to display banners for the Germanfest on public rights-of way and public property, as follows:

BACKGROUND

Sacred Heart will be hosting its annual German Fest carnival which will take place from July 17 through July 20, 2008. The church is requesting to be allowed to display banners for the German Fest on public rights-of way and public property, as follows:

- Crescent Tot Lot (NE corner of Crescent Boulevard & Finley Road)
- Lombard Lagoon (NE corner of Grace Street & Marcus Drive)
- Fire Station One

In the original Board packet distributed last week, their request was for a three week period.
