
Subject:

"No Parking" Jackson Street and Addison Avenue

Staff requests a change to the Village Traffic Code to post, "No Parking, Stopping Standing" on the south side of Jackson Street, from the intersection of Jackson Street and Addison Avenue to a point eighty (80) feet west. This posting will help with a sight-distance issue that was brought forward during the review of the Cambria Neighborhood parking situation. Limited sight-distance occurs at this intersection when vehicles queue along the south side of Jackson Street, as parents are waiting to pick up children from Jackson Middle School in Villa Park. Staff has asked Community Development's assistance in researching the ownership of Jackson Street east of the intersection with Addison Avenue, as there is the possibility that it is within the Village of Lombard Limits. This would allow for the Village to post a similar sign, eighty (80) feet to the east of this intersection. Otherwise, staff has contacted Villa Park and requested that, if the ownership of this portion of the street is theirs, they post a similar sign on the south side of Jackson Street, eighty (80) feet to the east of this intersection.
