Subject: Transportation and Safety Recommendations

The Transportation and Safety Committee recommended the following items for Board action:

- **060504 - "No Parking," Various Streets within Cambria:** The Committee recommends posting "No Parking" along the fire hydrant side of all roads within Cambria and posting "No Parking 8AM to 5PM, Monday - Friday" along the opposite side of all roads within Cambria.
- **060575 - Further Study of Need for Signalization at Fairfield and 22nd Intersection:** The Committee recommends waiting for the construction of the signalized intersection at Convention Way and 22nd Street, scheduled for spring 2007, and then assess if signalization, or some other improvement, is required.

Please present these items to the Board of Trustees at their regularly scheduled meeting on October 19, 2006 in accordance with the Committee's recommendations.

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE

ORDINANCE NO. _____

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule VII of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS be amended to add the following thereto:

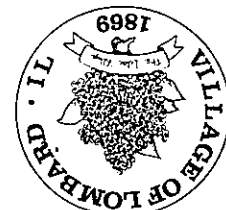

The Transportation and Safety Committee recommended the following item for Board action:

- 060504 - "No Parking," Various Streets within Cambria: The Committee recommends posting "No Parking" along the fire hydrant side of all roads within Cambria and posting "No Parking, Stopping, Standing 12PM to 4PM, Monday - Friday" along the opposite side of all roads within Cambria. Signing the fire hydrant side of these roads as "No Parking" will allow easier movement for fire and safety vehicles through the neighborhood. Signing the opposite side as "No Parking, Stopping, Standing 12PM to 4PM, Monday - Friday" will alleviate the issues with vehicles queuing within the subdivision as parents wait for to pick their children from the Jackson Middle School and also with the parking issues that occurred during certain services at the Islamic Foundation.

Please present this item to the Board of Trustees at their regularly scheduled meeting on November 7, 2006 in accordance with the Committee's recommendations.

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE

ORDINANCE NO. _____

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:
