In the bid documents was a provision to extend the contract for CA-6 Coarse Aggregate for one additional year. Attached is a letter from KOZ Trucking & Sons, Inc. indicating their willingness to provide the same service, terms, conditions and same unit prices for an additional year. I feel that it would be in the best interest of the Village to extend the contract at current prices.
