

**PROCLAMATION  
DU PAGE COUNTY RIVER SWEEP**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Lombard recognizes that stream cleaning is essential for the waterways of DuPage County and Northeastern Illinois; and

**WHEREAS**, DuPage County River Sweep is a countywide stream cleanup coordinated by the Conservation Foundation and held on May 22<sup>nd</sup>; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the River Sweep is to encourage residents and volunteer groups to “sweep our rivers clean” by picking up debris in and along our waterways; and

**WHEREAS**, the East Branch of the DuPage River flows along the western edge of the Village of Lombard; and

**WHEREAS**, stream cleaning efforts have been highly successful with more than 190 tons of solid waste removed from DuPage County streams since 1991;
