NEW THIS YEAR.....

### Used Clothing Collection

Goodwill Industries will be collecting used clothing in any condition. Goodwill diverts more than two billion pounds of clothing and household goods every year from landfills by recovering the value in people's unwanted material goods.

## ITEMS ACCEPTED

### BOOKS

Bring your old books. Any books that are not rescued (yes, you can come pick some up!) will be recycled.

### CAR & MARINE BATTERIES

Accepting all passenger car, truck, marine, RV and light utility batteries for recycling. (No household batteries)

### BICYCLES & SHOES

**Rotary Club** will be collecting bicycles, non-motorized wheelchairs, crutches and canes for **Working Bikes Cooperative**. They will also be collecting gently used shoes to be donated to the **Share Your Soles and Poised for Success** programs.

### AMERICAN FLAGS

**VFW** will accept American Flags for proper disposal.

## ITEMS ACCEPTED

### CELL PHONES

All cellular phones, working or not, and regardless of age. Phones, batteries and chargers will be accepted. Phones and any proceeds from the phones are donated to Family Shelter Services, a local organization which assists victims of domestic violence.

### ELECTRONICS

- Computers & peripherals including PCs, mainframes, modems, printers, monitors, terminals, drives (CD, tape & floppy), plotters, mouse, keyboards, scanners, software discs, CDs & DVDs.
- Office equipment & products including calculators, telephones, phone systems, answering machines, typewriters, adding machines, fax machines, copy machines, postage machines, pagers and shredders.
- Entertainment & visual equipment including TVs, VCRs, stereo equipment, cameras, camcorders, video game players and joysticks.
- Miscellaneous items including humidifiers, power tools, all small appliances such as toasters, toaster ovens, blenders, blow dryers, curling irons, irons, electric knives and food processors.

### SCRAP METAL

Hangers, old metal pots, swing sets, lawn furniture, gutters, washers & dryers, stoves, hot water heaters and dish washers. (Swing sets must be disassembled and the plastic seats are not accepted.)

### THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL BE COLLECTED BY VARIOUS SERVICE ORGANIZATIONS:

### EYEGASSES, HEARING AIDS

**Lion's Club** will be collecting eyeglasses, hearing aids and old metal keys.

### FLOWER POTS

The **Glenbard East Ecology Club** will be collecting clay and ceramic flower pots for re-use. Plastic pots will **NOT** be accepted.

### The following items are **NOT** accepted:

ANY Household Batteries  
Air conditioners  
Dehumidifiers  
Drywall  
Engine parts of any type

Household hazardous waste  
Freon appliances  
Furniture  
Items with gas or oil  
Microwaves

Lumber of any kind  
Paint of any type  
Particle board  
Plaster  
Propane or pressurized tanks

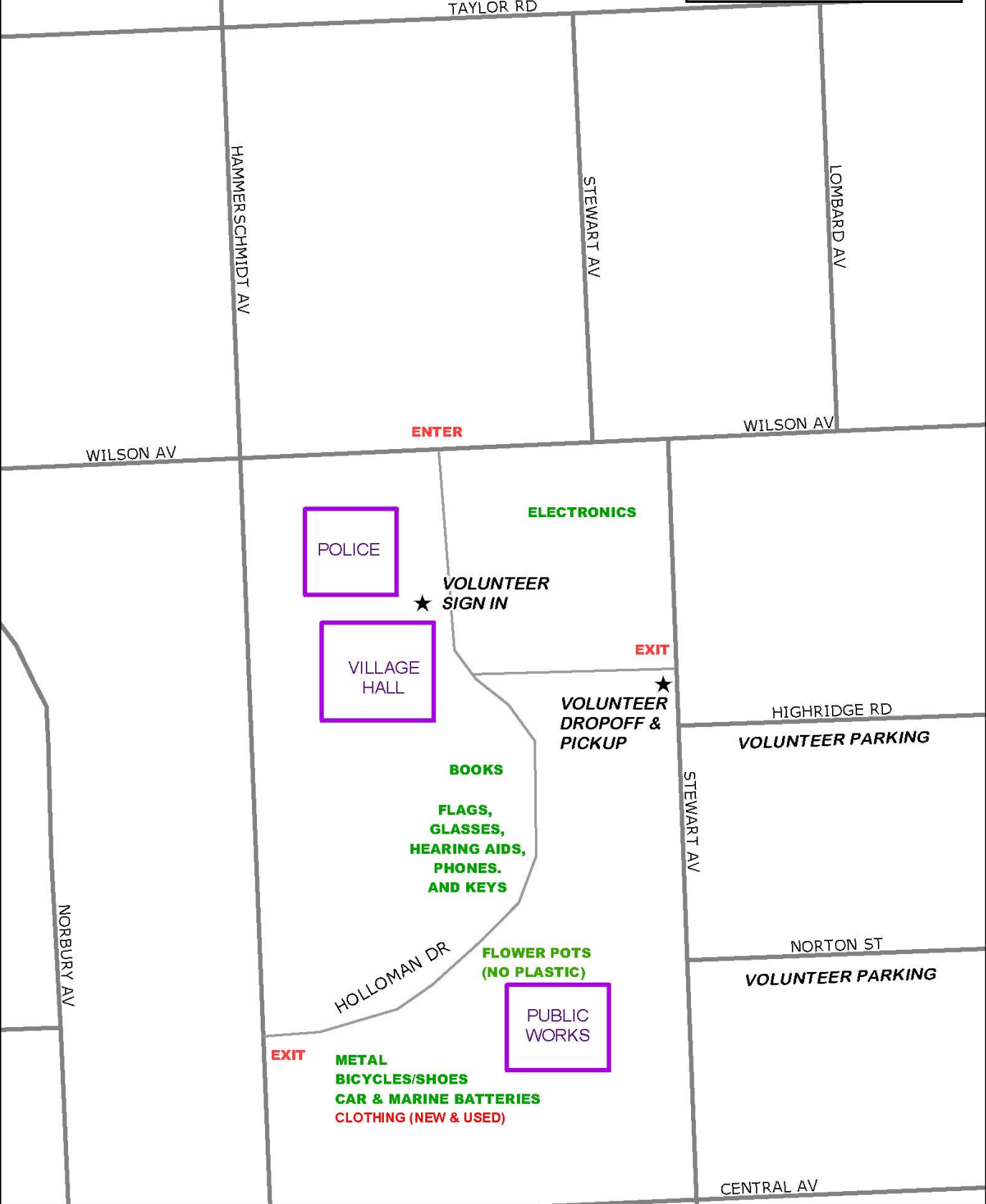
