BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

The 2023 property tax levy was presented to the Finance & Administration Committee at their meeting on September 11, 2023. The staff report on the Statutorily Permissible 2023 Tax Levy is attached. Below is the general overall summary of the tax levy:

It is estimated that new growth will account for 1.49% of the increase in the levy. If there is no new growth, there will be no levy for this. The amount that applies for all existing properties is 5.16%. For the owner of a \$300,000 house, the proposed increase will be approximately \$27.86.

The Finance & Administration Committee, at their meeting on September 11, 2023, voted unanimously to recommend the statutorily permissible 2023 tax levy to the President and Board of Trustees, and set the increase aside specifically for public safety building needs. This is reflected in the budget, transferring the levy increase amount out of the General Fund and to the Building Fund.
