CANCELLATION FEES

Please place before the Board of Trustees at their August 17, 2006 meeting an ordinance revising time limits, building permits and cancellation fees. The amendment clarifies application and provides tiered timelines.

No fee waiver for a single-family extension. Fee waiver at the direction of the Fire Chief for single-family regarding events beyond

the control of the applicant or owner.

Length of commercial permits not tiered for 100,000 square feet -12 months Size. <200,000 square feet -18 months

>200,000 square feet – 24 months

Existing Commercial permit extension no language.	Proposed May grant up to 2 extensions. Fee to be 10% of the original permit cost.
	Any additional plan review fees will be charged at 100% of the fee schedule.
No specific language to the re-issuance Of a permit that has become invalid.	Within 6 months of a permit becoming invalid a new permit must be issued.
	100% plan review and administration costs. 50% of all building permit fees.
	After 6 months 100% of all fees.
No language in keeping an idled site safe.	Require site to be kept safe. Failure to do so may result in the Fire Chief selecting a contractor to perform needed work at the owner's expense. If not paid in 30 days of invoice a lien shall be placed on the property.
No ticketing language for idle construction.	Once idle for six months, the applicant or owner may be responsible for fines up to \$750 per day.
