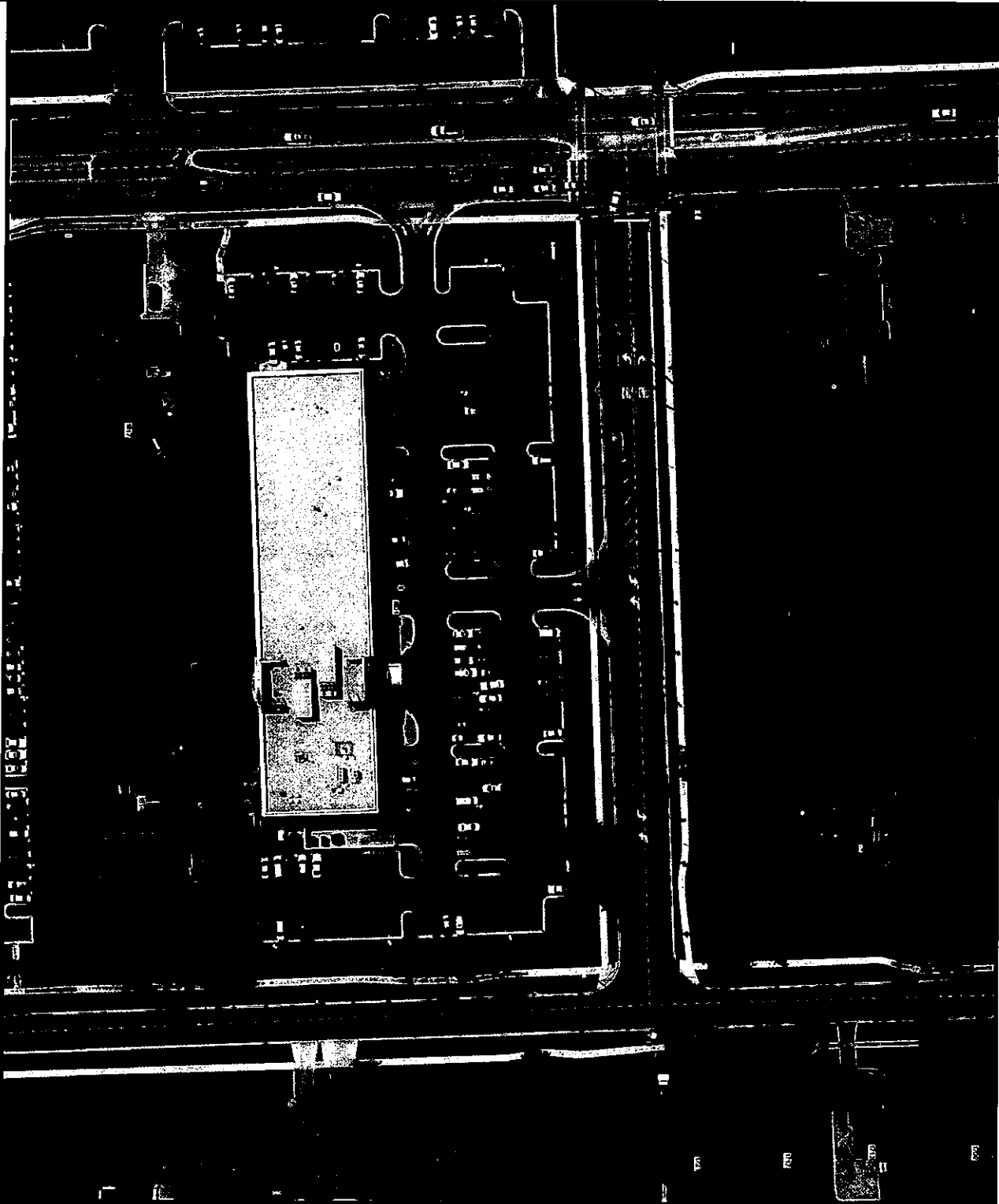
080736: Restrict Parking on Eastgate Road between Highland and Stewart Avenues
 On December 1, 2008, the Transportation and Safety Committee discussed eliminating periodic traffic impediments on Eastgate Road, which has been improved as a three-lane cross-section with adequate off-street parking to the south (see attached aerial map). The Committee voted to recommend implementing a No Parking Zone on the north and south sides of Eastgate Road as follows, which requires an ordinance to the Traffic Code.

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule VII of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS be amended to add the following thereto:

| Name of Street | From | To |
|---------------------------|---------------|--------------|
| Eastgate Rd., north side | Highland Ave. | Stewart Ave. |
| Eastgate Road, south side | Highland Ave. | Stewart Ave. |

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
