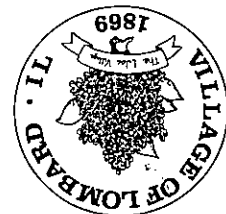

Subject: FY08 CIP: Waive Bid for Fleet Garage Exhaust Extraction System

The FY 2008 capital improvement budget includes upgrading the exhaust extraction system in the Village's fleet garage. Public Works requested quotes for this project rather than advertise for sealed bids since there are very few companies that install this type of equipment. Below are three quotes from local companies. Standard Industrial was the lowest bid but did not meet our requirements. We specified a 10 horsepower direct drive air handling system with a noise silencer. Their proposal included a 5 horsepower belt driven system without silencer. The system they offered would not be sufficient for fire trucks and would be noisy for surrounding residents. Hastings Air Energy of Lake Bluff (IL) was the lowest meeting our requirements. Additionally, Hastings Air has performed this work for the Village before at both fire stations. Hastings Air Energy specializes in installing extraction equipment used on trucks with high exhaust volumes such as the fire apparatus the fleet garage repairs.

The FY 2008 budget included \$5,000 for this Project. Since this project is a priority we propose to use money that was budgeted for other Fleet capital projects to make up the difference. Projects left unfunded would be resubmitted for the FY 2009 budget.

I recommend the BOT waive bid and award a contract to Hastings Air Energy of Lake Bluff (IL) in the amount of \$24,649 for updating the fleet garage exhaust extraction system. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the August 9, 2007 meeting.
