

Subject: Bid for police department replacement of our HVAC system-PD-0901.

On Monday, October 6, 2008, bids were opened for the replacement of the Police Department HVAC System. Bid specifications were sent out to twelve (12) vendors, with six (6) bidders responding for the project. After opening the bids, we had 4 that met the Village requirements and 2 that did not. The lowest bidder whose bid came in under budget was disqualified for not submitting the required Bid Deposit of 10%. The remaining bidders were all over budget with their bids, and the second lowest bidder was also disqualified for not following instructions in the Village's bidding document and not returning the entire document. We had a budgeted figure of \$300,000 for this project. The bid results follow:
