Re: 2007 Insurance Renewal

Dear Len:

The purpose of this letter is to provide a summary of and recommendation on the 2007 renewal terms. I have attached a spreadsheet that compares renewal costs to the current plan.

There is only one structural change in the program for 2007. The self-insured retention for workers compensation claims will be split between Police/Fire and all other Village employees. Police and Fire self-insured retention will increase from \$400,000 each claim to \$500,000. The reasons for the increase in the self-insured retention are both past Village loss experience (two recent large claims) and continued deteriorating industry results on workers compensation for Police and Fire.

The overall costs will increase slightly for 2007. All of the increase can be attributed to the increase in the tax interruption value at Yorktown to \$10,000,000.

There are no other coverage or structure changes for the 2007 renewal.
