Subject: Requested Elimination of No Parking on the North Side of Harding Road between Main and Charlotte Streets

The Village received a request to eliminate an existing No Parking Zone on the north side of Harding Road between Main and Charlotte Streets, as demonstrated on the attached map. Public Works staff investigated the request and learned the Transportation and Safety Committee recommended and Village Board approved the placement of this No Parking Zone (Ordinance #4957) in 2001. It is staff's understanding this Ordinance was approved to eliminate an on-street parking conflict between residents and a medical facility with inadequate parking located on the southeast corner of Harding Road and Main Street. Several years ago, the medical facility relocated and today, a sleep center is operating at the location. Adequate off-street parking is now provided for this facility, yet the No Parking Zone restriction on Harding Road remains.

Additional investigation by staff did not reveal No Parking Zones on Harding Road were affiliated with the Glenbard East High School Parking restrictions. Therefore, staff recommends removal of the No Parking Zone on the North Side of Harding as requested and as follows:

SCHEDULE VII – PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS		
In accordance with Section 10-13-6 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall, at any time, park a vehicle upon any of the following streets or parts of streets:
