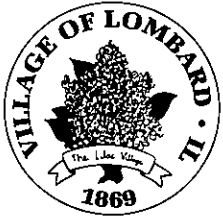
BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

Dear Mr. Mueller:


My name is Ibrahim Zayed and I have been a loyal resident of the Village of Lombard for the last twenty-one years. I have fond memories of birthday parties, graduations, and other celebrations at my beloved home. I would like to add to these memories by opening a business for my children in Lombard. I humbly write to you seeking a liquor license to assist me in opening a liquor store. Below, I will detail the specifics of this proposed business venture.

The idea for the store began when my daughter, Denise, 35, approached me with the desire to open her own business. ORDINANCE _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS** as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "F" liquor license category, contained therein to read as follows:

Class "F" – 5

SECTION 2: That the change in the number of Class "F" liquor licenses set forth in Section 1 above, is a result of granting a liquor license to Lombard Liquor Inc. d/b/a Lombard Liquor located at 420 W. 22nd Street, Lombard.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
