## **ORDINANCE NO. 6133**

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE I, CHAPTERS 10 AND 12, OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO PENALTY PROVISIONS

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That Section 10.99, entitled "General Penalty," of Chapter 10 of Title I is amended by deleting the phrase "upon conviction," to be and read as follows:

10.99 General Penalty

Any person, firm, or corporation, who violates any provisions of this Code for which another penalty is not specifically provided, shall be subject to a fine of not less than Fifty and No/100 Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than seven hundred and fifty and no/100 Dollars (\$750.00) and/or an order of the Court to correct the code violation by a time certain. A separate offense shall be deemed committed upon each day during which a violation occurs or continues.

**SECTION 2:** That Section 12.07, entitled "Penalty for Violation," of Chapter 12 of Title I is amended by deleting the phrase "on conviction," to be and read as follows:

12.07 Penalty for Violation.

Any person who violates any section, clause, or provision of any section of any ordinance for which there is no penalty provided, or shall fail to perform or omit to do any act or thing required by such section, clause or provision of any such ordinance shall be fined as set forth in §10.99.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its
passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.  Passed on first reading this day of, 2007.
