Subject: Police Squad Car Replacement

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On November 1, 2018 Lombard Police squad car unit # PP752 was totaled in an accident. This vehicle is a 2016 Ford Interceptor Utility and staff would like Board approval to purchase a replacement. Ford has already closed the order bank for the 2019 model year so a 2020 model year will be ordered with the hybrid drive system. The 2020 model year will begin production in June of 2019 so the replacement vehicle would be delivered in the fall of 2019.

The Ford Interceptor Utility is available for joint purchase through the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative (SPC). The current contract winner for the SPC is Currie Motors of Frankfort (IL). The Hybrid Interceptor Utility with the ready for the road package cost \$40,273.

I recommend the Board of Trustees award a contract to Currie Motors of Frankfort (IL) in the amount of \$40,273 for a new Ford Hybrid Police Interceptor Utility. I also recommend declaring Village unit number PP752 as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorize its disposal. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the November 15, 2018 meeting.
