Sir:

The Illinois Law Enforcement Alarm System (ILEAS) is the largest and most effective law enforcement mutual aid organization in the United States. Over 900 counties, cities, and other units of local government have joined ILEAS, with the Village of Lombard being an ILEAS member since its inception in 2003. The purpose in being a member agency is to reduce costs and increase effectiveness of local law enforcement through the combining and sharing of resources during a time of disaster or law enforcement issues that arise where mutual aid is needed.

Although we already have an agreement in place, ILEAS has enhanced the system providing an online database showing agency resources and equipment. ILEAS is requesting every member agency renew their membership under this enhanced system that will take the organization into the next generation. I would recommend the Village of Lombard authorize the agreement with ILEAS to provide and offer assistance during times of statewide or county requests of mutual aid.

A waiver of first reading is being requested facilitate this agreement.
