(B) Proof of Educational Training Compliance. Upon making application for the July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008 tobacco dealer's license, and for all subsequent license periods thereafter, the tobacco dealer's license holder shall supply the Village with copies of the course completion certificate(s) for all management personnel who have successfully completed the Tobacco Program. A copy of the Tobacco Program completion certificate(s) shall also be made available at all times at the licensed premises for inspection by the Lombard Police Department.

(A) Effective with the July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008 tobacco dealer's license period, and for all license periods thereafter, all tobacco dealer's license holders shall be required to have at least one management person, who is responsible for employee training (the owner, the business manager or an employee supervisor), take and successfully complete the Lombard Police Department's Responsibly Selling Tobacco Products Training Program (hereinafter the "Tobacco Program" for purposes of this Section 120.16) and thereafter maintain a current effective certification from said Tobacco Program.

loss of a management employee who has successfully completed

the Tobacco Program, is put in a position of non-compliance with

Subsection A above, shall have sixty (60) days to come into

compliance.

(C) Compliance by New License Holders. All new tobacco

dealer's license holders who obtain a tobacco dealer's license

subsequent to July 1, 2007, shall be given sixty (60) days from the

date of issuance of the tobacco dealer's license to come into

compliance with Subsections A and B above relative to the

Tobacco Program requirement.
