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### **2019 Pavement Marking Replacement Program**

The purpose of the 2019 Pavement Marking Program is to replace deteriorated and damaged pavement markings around school crossings, Finley Road (IL Route 38 to the Village limits) and 22<sup>nd</sup> Street (Finley Road to Meyers Road).

DuPage County opened bids for a County-wide project on April 9, 2019 and awarded the 2019 Pavement Marking Maintenance Program to Superior Road Striping, Inc. of Melrose Park, IL on May 14, 2019 by Resolution DT-R-0177-19. Superior included a Joint Purchase Form with their bid package to extend their bid prices to other taxing bodies in DuPage County. Attached is a schedule of pricing for this project.

### **Recommendation:**

**CONTRACT DOCUMENT NUMBER RM-PROG 34**

This agreement is made this 5th day of September 2019, between and shall be binding upon the Village of Lombard, an Illinois municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Village") and Superior Road Striping, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor") and their respective successors.

Witnessed, that in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties delineated in the Contract Documents, the Contractor agrees to perform the services and the Village agrees to pay for the following services as set forth in the Contract Documents:

The removal of existing pavement markings and the replacement with thermoplastic or modified urethane pavement markings consisting of various colors, sizes, and shapes. Project quantities are attached for various sections of concrete and asphalt throughout Village limits.

- School crossings/ crosswalks;
- Finley Road (IL RTE 38 south to Village limits);
- 22<sup>nd</sup> Street (Finley Road to Meyers Road).

1. This contract shall embrace and include all of the applicable Contract Documents listed below as if attached hereto or repeated herein:

a. Contract Document Number RM-PROG-34 for 2019 Pavement Marking Replacement Program, consisting of the following:

- i) DuPage County Division of Transportation

- ii) DuPage County Resolution DT-R-0177-19 (May 14, 2019 reference only)  
Awarding to Superior Road Striping, Inc. of Melrose Park, IL
- iii) Village of Lombard quantities (attached)

b. Bid Tabulation of County Awarded Schedule of Prices Dated: April 9, 2019 (attached)

c. Required Performance and Payment Bonds and Certificate(s) of Insurance **MIA**

2. The Village agrees to pay, and the Contractor agrees to accept as full payment, the amount as shown on the Contractor's Bid Proposal, which is made a part hereof, subject to such additions and deletions as agreed to by the parties hereto.

- 3. The Contractor shall commence work under this Contract upon written Notice to Proceed from the Village and shall complete work under this contract within 30 calendar days from the date of the Notice to Proceed. Time is of the essence in regard to this Contract, and the Contractor agrees to achieve completion within the time permitted by all proper and appropriate means including working overtime without additional compensation.
- 4. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 5 of the Mechanics' Lien Act of Illinois, prior to making any payment to the Contractor under this Contract, the Village demands that the Contractor furnish a written statement of the names of all parties furnishing labor and/or materials under this Contract and the amounts due or to become due each. This statement must be made under oath or be verified by affidavit. The Village shall not issue final payment nor shall any retained percentage become due until releases and waivers of lien have been supplied as the Village designates.
- 5. This Contract represents the entire agreement between the parties and may not be modified without the written approval of both parties.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Village of Lombard, Illinois, and the Contractor have each hereunto caused this Contract to be executed by their respective duly authorized representatives this 5th day of September, 2019.
