Subject:

Motorcycle/Moped Parking and Security Devices

At the May 5, 2003 Transportation and Safety Committee meeting, the committee requested cost estimates to install security devices for motorcycles and mopeds in the daily fee lot at the DuPage theater property.

According to Tom Bayer, Village Attorney, the Village has no obligation to supply security devices for motorcycles and mopeds. If the Village installs these security devices the Village must maintain these devices for liability reasons.

The cost estimate for each security device is \$100 per parking stall. There are 9 available slots in the coin box that could be used for motorcycles and moped parking. The security device consists of a 4"x 4"x 4"long x 1/4" thick steel post with a round 2" eyebolt welded to it. Each post will be secured in a hole 18" to 24" deep with concrete. Each post will be painted bright yellow for visibility.

Subject:

Parking Spaces for Moped/Motorcycles in the Daily Fee Lots

At the April 7, 2003 Transportation and Safety Committee meeting the committee requested staff to investigate additional parking for mopeds/motorcycles in the daily fee lots.

History

In the east Parkside daily fee lot the Village assigned stall #1 as motorcycle parking. According to the Community Service Officers from the Police Department this stall is utilized by commuters during the summer months and a small compact car will use it during the winter months.

Proposed Solution

In the daily fee lot of the DuPage Theater there is a 100-coin slot pay box. The Village uses slots 1-91; this leaves 9 potential parking spaces for moped/motorcycles. These 9 spaces could be added at the east side of the theater. The distance between the east wall of the theater and the fence to the east is 36 feet. This distance falls short of 7 feet to allow car or truck parking in this area. The Village could stripe five-foot wide parking stalls for 9 mopeds and/or motorcycles. These stalls would be solely for moped/motorcycle parking.

In conclusion, if these stalls were added it would utilize all 100 coin box slots and increase revenue for the Village.
