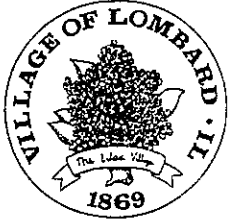

On Tuesday, July 12, 2005, bids were opened for Water & Sewer System Supplies. Two companies responded to the bid and they are:

National Waterworks, Inc

Elk Grove, IL 60007

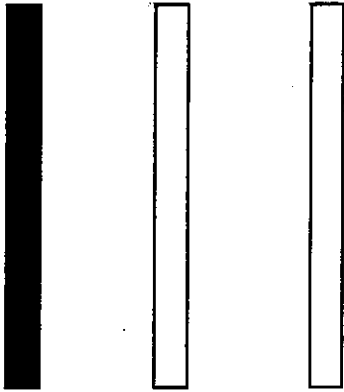
Bids were broken down into twelve categories. The total cost of the bid was based upon the total of all categories. Two companies, National Waterworks, Inc. and Ziebell Water Service Products, submitted prices on all of the required materials. The bid tabulation is attached. National Waterworks submitted the low bid.

In the past the number of items in each category was based upon the projected need during the upcoming year. This year, the bid items are the items required to meet our minimum inventory, not the total needed for the year. Prices were obtained for all of the items kept in stock but purchases will only be made to maintain designated inventory levels. Therefore, the contract will be awarded for the entire budget of \$83,420 for the purchase of water/sewer system supplies throughout the year on an as needed basis.

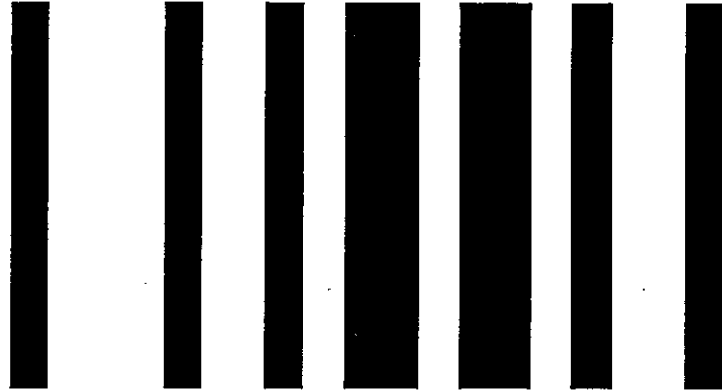

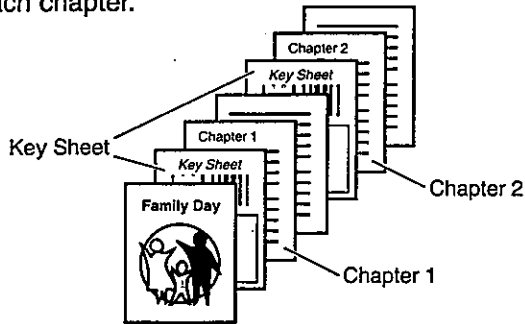

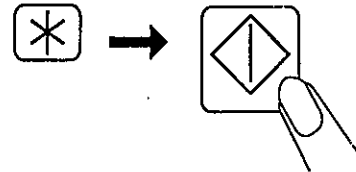
