On May 23, 2008, seven bids were received for the Catch Basin Cleaning project. This project is designed to supplement the annual catch basin cleaning program performed by Village crews. The Village has a goal of cleaning one-third of the Village-owned catch basins each year. This program is one component of the Combined Sewer Overflow Operations & Maintenance Plan required by the IEPA Permit for the Lombard Combined Sewerage Treatment Plant to reduce sediment entering the treatment plant during rain storms.

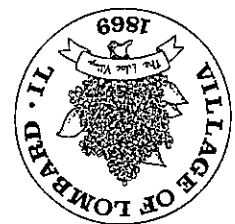

CONTRACT DOCUMENT NUMBER PWU-0934

This agreement is made this 5th day of June, 2008 by and between, and shall be binding upon, the Village of Lombard, an Illinois municipal Corporation hereinafter referred to as (the "Village") and () hereinafter referred to as (the "Contractor").

Witnesseth That in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties delineated in the Contract Documents, the Contractor agrees to perform the services and the Village agrees to pay for the following services as set forth in the Contract Documents:

Clean catch basins, and lateral lines as needed, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.

1. This Contract shall embrace and include all of the applicable Contract Documents listed below as if attached hereto or repeated herein:

a. Specification and Contract Document no. PWU-0934 for Catch Basin Cleaning Project, consisting of the following:

i) Cover Sheet

ii) Table of Contents

iii) Invitation to Bid on Contract Document No. PWU-0934- Legal Notice

iv) General Terms, Conditions and Instructions

v) Specific Terms, Conditions and Instructions

vi) Bid Proposal Form

vii) Plans and Specifications and Specification Deviation Form

b. The Contractor's Bid Proposal Dated May 16, 2008

c. Required Performance and Payment Bonds and Certificate of Insurance

2. The Village agrees to pay, and the Contractor agrees to accept as full payment for the services which are the subject matter of this Contract the total sum not to

exceed \$50,000 paid in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Prompt Payment Act and the provisions of the Contract Documents.

3. Contractor shall not delegate the duties involved in the performance of the services which are the subject matter of this Contract without the written approval of the Village.

4. This Contract represents the entire agreement between the parties and may not be modified without the written approval of both parties.

5. Where the terms of this Contract conflict with the provisions of the Contract Documents, the Contract Documents shall be binding.
