ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 121 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO TAXICAB LICENSING

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 121, Section 121.01 of the Lombard Village Code is amended by deleting the definitions of "POLICE DEPARTMENT" and "TRANSPORTATION AND SAFETY COMMITTEE" therefrom.

SECTION 2: That Title 11, Chapter 121, Section 121.02(C) of the Lombard Village Code is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(C) Taximeter Devices.

All Taxicabs shall be equipped with a Taximeter which has been inspected, tested and certified by a company that calibrates and seals meters."

SECTION 3: That Title 11, Chapter 121, Section 121.07(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the reference therein to, "Transportation and Safety Committee," to read, "Village Manager."

SECTION 4: That Title 11, Chapter 121, Section 121.07(C) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the reference therein to, "Transportation and Safety Committee," to read, "Village Manager."

SECTION 5: That Title 11, Chapter 121, Section 121.07(D) of the Lombard Village Code is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(D) Suspension/Revocation of Business License.

The Village Manager shall provide at least ten (10) calendar days notice to the Business Licensee prior to conducting a hearing to consider the suspension or revocation of a Business License, based upon any violation of this Chapter. In case of an emergency, where there is imminent danger to the safety of the public or passengers, the Village Manager may temporarily suspend any Business License issued pursuant to this Chapter without prior notice, but shall grant a hearing on such suspension within seven (7) calendar days of taking such action."

SECTION 6: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
