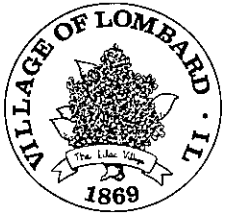

ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS** as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entries relative to the Class A/B-II liquor license category, contained therein effective June 1, 2004, to read as follows:

Class "A/B-II" – 9

Section 2: That the change in the number of Class A/B-II liquor licenses set forth in Section 1 above, is a result of granting a liquor license to Tocar Inc. doing business as Ristorante Lorica located at 203 Yorktown Center, Lombard.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
