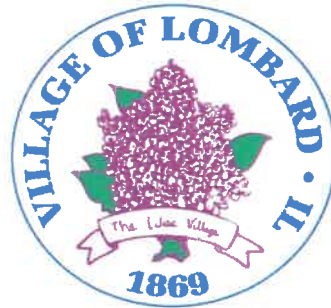

**ORDINANCE NO. 8132**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3, CHAPTERS 31, 33 AND 34  
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO RESIDENTIAL  
PROXIMITY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE POSITIONS OF FIRE CHIEF  
POLICE CHIEF, AND DEPUTY FIRE CHIEF**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That Title 3, Chapter 31, §31.65(A) of the Lombard Village Code is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

“(A) The Fire Chief and Deputy Fire Chief of the village are hereby required to have residency as required by Title 3, Chapter 33, §33.24 of the Village Code.”

**SECTION 2:** That Title 3, Chapter 33, §33.24(A) and (B) of the Lombard Village Code is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

“(A) The Fire Chief and Deputy Fire Chief shall be required to reside within the village or within thirty (30) miles of any point on the corporate boundary of the village.

(B) Any person appointed to the position of Fire Chief or Deputy Fire Chief, who does not meet the requirement of this section at the time of appointment, shall have one year to come into compliance with this section from the date of appointment. The Village Manager shall have the discretion to grant said person additional time to come into compliance with this section based on a showing of hardship.”

**SECTION 3:** That Title 3, Chapter 34, § 34.27(A) of the Lombard Village Code is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

“(A) The Police Chief shall be required to reside within the village or within thirty (30) miles of any point on the corporate boundary of the Village.”

**SECTION 4:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


