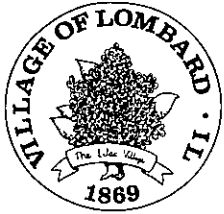

Attached please find a contract and resolution pertaining to the resident engineering services for South Broadway Improvements – East of Chase.

This selection was made as part of the new FY2007 and FY2008 Resident Engineering Short-List. The South Broadway project was used as the “target” project to establish the Resident Engineering Short list. The Public Works evaluation team concurred that Christopher B Burke Engineering Ltd. (CBBEL) of Rosemont is the most qualified firm to serve as resident engineer for the project.

CBBEL has served as resident engineer for several projects in Lombard. Recent projects include; South Broadway Improvements – West of Chase, Lombard Hills - East (Phase 5) and Prairie Path Lighting.

The scope and fee were negotiated with CBBEL and agreed to by both parties. The not-to-exceed fee for resident engineering services is \$114,917.88

Please present this agreement and resolution to the President and Board of Trustees for their review at their regular meeting of March 2, 2006. If approved, please have both signed copies returned to Engineering for further processing.

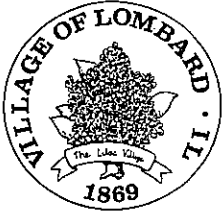
