Subject: In-House Paving Program, Lombard Circle and School St.

The Village of Lombard's in-house paving program is conducted using Village owned equipment and rented equipment. The paving season is quickly coming to an end due to the changing weather temperatures. The colder temperatures make it more difficult to pave asphalt. The heated material must be applied at temperatures ranging from 180 degrees to 220 degrees. Cold material is susceptible to a variety of deficiencies such as loss of compactability, adhesion and cracking. Staff would like to include Lombard Circle and a section of School Street to this year's program. These streets have advance degradation and will require constant winter maintenance after each snow event.

Typically, the milling of the streets that is paved by village crews has been included in the contract for street resurfacing not done by village crews. Village staff has investigated alternatives for milling of the Lombard Circle and School Streets. The current contractor under contract has stated they are unable to mill the asphalt on these streets until late October.

Staff has requested quotes from three other contractors capable of performing this work. Arrow Road Construction has indicated that they would be able to complete the work within a week of the notice to proceed and at a cost of \$0.05 per square yard under contract price.
