Glenview Avenue Speed Limit Modification

The Police Department received a petition to lower the Glenview speed limit to 25 mph, and the speed limit modification will include the street portion north of St. Charles Road. Twelve households are represented on the petition. Public Works and the Police Department discussed the street and related intersection. Based on measured speeds, the study justified that the street was a candidate for a modified speed limit. The resident petition showed support for a speed limit modification, and the measured speeds were aligned with the speed limit request. Staff recommended approving the speed limit modification request.

During the December 7, 2015 meeting, the Public Safety and Transportation Committee voted to recommend modifying the speed limit in accordance with staff recommendation.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety and Transportation Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule I of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) is amended to add the following restriction:

“Glenview Avenue from St. Charles Road to Dead End at 25 MPH.”

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
