Design Engineering Contract

The Hammerschmidt Pond Improvements project is a stormwater management improvement project. The project consists of the evaluation of alternatives to increase the storage capacity of the Hammerschmidt Pond. The evaluation of drainage improvements at the intersection of Hammerschmidt Avenue and New Street and along Stewart Avenue is included in the scope of work. This work is for preliminary design engineering only. Final design will be negotiated after completion of this phase and the final scope of work is determined.

A Request For Proposal (RFP) was included in the Village's Hydraulics and Hydrology short list of firms request for qualifications and proposal. Baxter & Woodman, Inc. (Baxter) was determined to be the most qualified firm. Baxter has previously performed work for the Village. The project scope and fee was directly negotiated with Baxter and agreed to by both parties.

This work will be performed for a total not to exceed engineering fee of \$97,671. The engineering costs will be paid through the Sewer and Water Capital Reserve Fund. This project was not included in the current CIP.

Please present this agreement and resolution for Design Engineering services to the President and Board of Trustees for their review at their regular meeting of April 17, 2014. If approved, please return two original signed copies of the agreement to Public Works-Engineering for further processing.
