

## ORDINANCE NO. 4413

## AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A VARIATION OF THE LOMBARD ZONING ORDINANCE TITLE 15, CHAPTER 155 OF THE CODE OF LOMBARD, ILLINOIS

ZBA 98-01: 130 East Washington Boulevard, Lombard, Illinois

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore adopted the Lombard Zoning Ordinance, otherwise known as Title 15, Chapter 155 of the Code of Lombard, Illinois; and,

WHEREAS, the subject property is zoned R2 Single-Family Residence District; and,

WHEREAS, an application has been filed with the Village of Lombard requesting a variation from Title 15, Chapter 155, Sections 406 (F)2 of said Zoning Ordinance, to allow a residential addition 13.8 feet from the corner side property line (twenty feet required); and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been conducted by the Zoning Board of Appeals on January 28, 1998 pursuant to appropriate and legal notice; and,

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals has forwarded its findings to the Board of Trustees with a recommendation of approval to allow a residential addition 13.8 feet from the corner side property line; and,

WHEREAS, President and Board of Trustees have determined that it is in the best interest of the Village of Lombard to approve the requested variation; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That a variation is hereby granted from the provisions of Title 15, Chapter 155, Section 406 (F)2 of the Lombard Zoning Ordinance, for the property described in Section 2 below.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance is limited and restricted to the property generally located at 130 East Washington Boulevard, Lombard, Illinois, and legally described as follows:

Lot 5 (except that part of said Lot 5 lying East of a line drawn parallel to and 15 feet West of the East line of said Lot) in the resubdivision of Lots 2, 3, 5, 6, 7 and that part of Lot 8, lying West of the West line of Martha Street in Morningside Subdivision in the Southwest Quarter of Section 8, Township 39 North, Range 11, East of the Third Principal Meridian, according to the plat of said resubdivision, recorded February 28, 1927 as Document 230495 in DuPage County, Illinois.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be granted subject to compliance with the following condition:

after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

This ordinance shall become null and void unless work thereon is substantially under way within twelve months of the effective date of this ordinance, unless extended by the Board of Trustees as per Section 103-C, paragraph 10 of said Zoning Ordinance.
